GED® Test Steps:

Step 1: Create Your Account	<input type="checkbox"/> Go to <u>GED.com</u> and select " Sign Up " to create your account. <input type="checkbox"/> You will need an active email account.								
Step 2: Complete Registration Questions	<input type="checkbox"/> Once you complete these questions, <u>please contact the campus</u> where you wish to take the test. Provide your name and phone number. Tell them that you need to be "approved." Step 3: Provide Additional Documentation (if necessary)	<input type="checkbox"/> If you are under 18 years of age, you will need to provide additional documentation before being approved to register for the test. Contact our school for more information.								
Step 4: Schedule Your Test and Make Payment	<input type="checkbox"/> Log back into your account. Select your choice of test(s), location, date and time. <input type="checkbox"/> Pay for the test online using a credit card. <input type="checkbox"/> If you choose more than one test at a time, you will only be shown days and times that testing centers are open long enough for your selections. You may want to choose one test at a time to access more availability options. <input type="checkbox"/> Select "Proceed to Checkout" and make payment using a credit card. <input type="checkbox"/> Rescheduling of tests is conducted on your account and not through WCSA. <input type="checkbox"/> Contact GED Testing Service® directly for any refunds. 100% of your test fee is refunded by them if you reschedule or cancel up to 24 hours before your test appointment.								
Step 5: Take the Test	<input type="checkbox"/> Report to your testing center a few minutes earlier. <input type="checkbox"/> Bring a valid photo ID with birth date to the testing center.								
Step 6: View your Scores and GED® Transcript	<input type="checkbox"/> Go to your account and select "My Scores" and "View Results" to see and print your full score report. <input type="checkbox"/> Scores are usually available from a few hours to a few days after completing a test. <input type="checkbox"/> After you pass the GED®Tests, you'll receive a GED® Transcript to apply to college, start training, or get a better job.								
Obtaining your Community School Diploma	<input type="checkbox"/> If you wish to earn a CS Diploma in addition to the GED transcript, you will need to provide an official transcript (unopened and sealed) from an accredited private/public high school in Hawaii or Hawaii Community School for Adults.
