Step 2: Create Your Account	<input type="checkbox"/> Go to www.hiset.ets.org to create your account. <input type="checkbox"/> You will need an active email account. Write down your ETS ID NUMBER.										
Step 3: Register and Make Payment at the WCSA Campus	<input type="checkbox"/> Go to the campus you wish to test at to register and make payment. <input type="checkbox"/> You will be completing several forms so please be sure to allow yourself at least half an hour. PLEASE BRING YOUR ETS ID NUMBER. <input type="checkbox"/> We accept cash only. Please have the exact amount.										
Step 4: (if necessary) Provide Additional Documentation	<input type="checkbox"/> If you are under 18 years of age, you will need to provide additional documentation before being approved to register for the test. Contact our school for more information.										
Step 5: What You Need to Bring on Testing Day	<input type="checkbox"/> When you check in, you will be asked for identification. Your ID must have four things to be valid and acceptable: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. your name exactly as entered when you created your HiSET account 2. your signature 3. your date of birth 4. a recent, recognizable photograph <input type="checkbox"/> If the test center administrator questions your first ID, you will be asked to provide a second ID that matches the above requirements.										
Step 6: View your Scores	<input type="checkbox"/> Report to your testing center at least 15 minutes early. <input type="checkbox"/> Scores are available through your HiSET account; they are not sent by mail. <input type="checkbox"/> Official <i>HiSET®</i> scores are posted within: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3–5 business days after a multiple-choice test • 6–10 business days after an essay test <input type="checkbox"/> After you pass the 5 HiSET® Tests, contact the campus where you took the test to request transcripts.										
Obtain your Community School Diploma	<input type="checkbox"/> If you wish to earn a CS Diploma in addition to the HiSET transcript, you will need to provide an official transcript (unopened and sealed) from an accredited private/public high school in Hawaii or Hawaii Community School for Adults.
