<b>Step 1: Contact WCSA for Testing Schedule</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Contact the Waipahu Community School for Adults Campus you plan to test at for testing dates and times. <b>Step 2: Create Your Account</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> All 5 Subtests must be taken at the same campus. <input type="checkbox"/> Go to <b>www.hiset.ets.org</b> to create your account. <input type="checkbox"/> You will need an active email account. Write down your ETS ID NUMBER.										
<b>Step 3: Register and Make Payment at the WCSA Campus</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Go to the Campus you wish to test at to register and make payment. <input type="checkbox"/> You will be completing several forms so please be sure to allow yourself at least half an hour. PLEASE BRING YOUR ETS ID NUMBER. <input type="checkbox"/> <b>We accept cash only. Please have exact amount.</b>										
<b>Step 4: (if necessary) Provide Additional Documentation</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> If you are under 18 years of age, you will need to provide additional documentation before being approved to register for the test. Contact our school for more information.										
<b>Step 5: What you Need to Bring on Testing Day</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> When you check in, you will be asked for identification. Your ID must have four things to be valid and acceptable: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. your name exactly as entered when you created your HiSET account</li> <li>2. your signature</li> <li>3. your date of birth</li> <li>4. a recent, recognizable photograph</li> </ol> <input type="checkbox"/> If the test center administrator questions your first ID, you will be asked to provide a second ID that matches the above requirements. <input type="checkbox"/> Report to your testing center at least 15 minutes early.										
<b>Step 6: View your Scores</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> Scores are available through your HiSET account; they are not sent by email. <input type="checkbox"/> Official HiSET® scores are posted within: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3-5 business days after a multiple-choice test</li> <li>• 6-10 business days after an essay test</li> </ul> <input type="checkbox"/> After you pass the 5 HiSET® Tests, contact Diploma Sender @ <a href="http://www.diplomasender.com">www.diplomasender.com</a> to request your HiSET transcript										
<b>Obtain your Community School Diploma</b>	<input type="checkbox"/> If you wish to earn a CS Diploma in addition to the HiSET transcript, you will need to provide an official transcript (unopened and sealed) from an accredited private/public high school in Hawaii or Hawaii Community School for Adults
